## CHILD CARE

Child care is available on site. Two certified day care providers will be available at the rate of \$18 per day for each child. The three-hour morning block will be \$8 per child and the 4-hour afternoon block is \$12/child. Students will be accepted on a "drop-in" basis for \$3 per hour per child if space is available. No child care will be available during the noon hour. A minimum number of children are required for child care to be available.
