

**Violin Teacher Application
Susan Bauman Memorial Scholarship**

It is the intention of the Idaho Suzuki Association that dividends accruing from investment of Susan Bauman's memorial gifts be used for scholarship grants **(1) to encourage and motivate teachers attending the Idaho Suzuki Institute to further their teaching abilities by attending local, state, regional, national or international Suzuki workshops or conferences** and (2) to broaden the musical experiences of Idaho Suzuki Institute students by allowing them to attend other Suzuki Institutes or alternative musical instruction.

Student Scholarship:

A scholarship toward tuition for one unit of teacher training, not to exceed \$300, at any Suzuki Institute will be awarded to a teacher applicant who is a current member of ISA and a paid participant of one of the last four Idaho Suzuki Institute training workshops.

Application due **February 15, 2010**. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the institute or conference. Application maybe made for reimbursement for instruction retroactive to January 1 of the same year may be applied. Teachers may not receive this scholarship in consecutive years.

Complete application and references must be received prior to February 15, 2010. Late entries will not be considered. Applications will be reviewed by qualified, impartial panel. You will be notified by March 1, 2010 via email..
